Program Background:

Eligibility:

Applicants must be ethnic minority (African American, Asian, Hispanic/Latino, Multiracial/ethnic, Native-American) undergraduate students who have already applied and been accepted to participate in a study abroad program (includes intern, volunteer, teach or intensive language) during the spring 2008 term (January 2008 - May 2008).

Requirements:

Here's what we expect from the grant awardees:

- Post a blog a minimum once a week (do more if you can, we want to hear from you!)
- Whenever possible add a picture or video to your blog
- Blog about any and everything going on while your abroad (rule of thumb, if you wouldn't say it in front of your parents, aunts, uncles, bosses...etc; don't put it in your blog)
- Be sure to talk about the benefits that you are getting from being abroad
- Share your blog with your friends. Study abroad is an amazing experience and we want you to inspire your friends to go abroad as well.

How to Apply:

Applying for the DiversityAbroad.com Blog Abroad Grant is easy. Fill out the application on page 2. In 250 words or less answer this question "How will you use your DiversityAbroad.com blog to inspire other students to study abroad?" Email us the application along with a photo. Grant winners will be announced in the beginning of January 2008.
